
School Photos

PERMISSION NOTES AND PAYMENTS

As you can appreciate when we have excursions/ incursions there is a lot of organisation needed to make the event run as smoothly as possible;

- students need to be confirmed/teachers need to know who will or won't be attending
- numbers need to be in prior to attending
- deposits to organisations may need to be made
- non-attending students need to be allocated to appropriate learning areas

Please ensure that your child comes to school in full school uniform. This includes school hat, grey socks for boys, white socks for girls, a royal blue jacket or jumper and black shoes. Information was sent home last week regarding R U OK? Day on Tuesday 18th September. Your child will be involved in an information session regarding strategies for dealing with bullying, online safety and the concept of 'checking in' on their mates. Students are asked to wear 'yellow' mufti on the day. Please note a gold coin donation is **NOT** required for this day. Merchandise will be available to purchase on the day. 


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
